You can be confident that your child will get the highest standard of care while boarding at the college.


Experienced and qualified staff support your child's learning and personal development throughout the term. Staff are on-site 24 hours a day to ensure students are well supervised and their needs are met.


City Beach Residential College

Boarding for gifted and talented students.

Your child can live in a residential college that nurtures their gift and extends their talent.

Boarding at the college

City Beach Residential College provides boarding for up to 66 country students who attend Perth Modern School, John Curtin College of the Arts and other metropolitan schools with Gifted and Talented Secondary Selective Programs.

The college is situated in City Beach approximately 15 minutes from Perth's CBD and with easy access to students' schools, local beaches and community facilities.



As a boarder your child will be encouraged to foster:

- their creativity and independence
- an interest in others and the world around them
- a passion for learning and extending their talent.

They will also have the opportunity to develop a wide circle of like-minded friends who will support and encourage them through their challenging and fulfilling study program.

Your child can benefit from all that Perth has to offer while living close to bushland and the ocean.

Accommodation

Your child can enjoy modern and comfortable accommodation in a bushland setting. They will live in one of the college's 11 townhouses, sharing with up to six other students of the same gender and similar age.

Each townhouse has:

- six large single bedrooms
- a lounge room
- three bathrooms
- kitchenette facilities
- wireless internet connection.

All bedrooms are furnished with a long single bed, study desk, wardrobe and air-conditioning.

Facilities

Your child can access an array of recreational facilities on-site and in the community. The college has two ovals, an indoor gymnasium and a recreation room equipped with pool tables, foosball and table tennis.

Close to the college there are sporting fields, tennis courts, pools, a library and other community facilities.

From 2018, the college will have a new kitchen, dining and recreation room - including study and music areas.



A healthy balance between study and recreation is promoted so your child enjoys life as a boarder.

Study

As a boarder, your child's education is supported by compulsory study times that align with the recommendations of their school.

Year 7 to 9 students have access to a tutor three afternoons a week and are supervised during their study periods.

Year 10 to 12 students are offered both study skills and exam preparation courses to complement their outstanding education.



Recreation

The college offers a wide variety of recreational activities during the week and at weekends. These activities are run at the college and off-site. Generally they require no additional financial contribution.

While at the college, your child is encouraged to continue sport and social clubs they have enjoyed while at home. College staff are happy to assist your child with joining nearby clubs.
