

Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check Identification requirements

You must provide 4 items of identification, as follows:

- 1 from Commencement of identity documents
- 1 from Primary use in the community documents
- 2 from Secondary use in the community documents
- at least 1 of your 4 documents must include a recent photograph of you.
- all identification must be current (we cannot accept expired documents).
- if you provide identity documents in a former name, for example, in your 'maiden' name, you must provide evidence of the name change, in addition to your identity documents.

Commencement of identity documents

- (a) Full Australian birth certificate (not an extract or birth card)
- (b) Current Australian passport (not expired)
- (c) Australian visa current at time of entry to Australia as a resident or tourist
- (d) ImmiCard issued by Department of Home Affairs that enables the cardholder to prove their visa and/or migration status and enrol in services
- (e) Certificate of identity issued by Foreign Affairs and Trade to refugees and non-Australian citizens for entry to Australia
- (f) Document of identity issued by Foreign Affairs and Trade to Australian citizens or persons who have the nationality of a Commonwealth country for travel purposes
- (g) Certificate of evidence of resident status
- (h) Australian Citizenship Certificate

(a) Current Australian driver's licence, learner permit or provisional licence issued by a state or territory, showing a signature and/or photo and the same name as claimed

Primary use in the community documents

- (b) Australian marriage certificate issued by a state or territory (church or celebrant-issued certificates are not accepted)
- (c) Current **passport** issued by a country other than Australia with a valid entry stamp or visa
- (d) Current proof of age or photo identity card issued by an Australian Government agency in the name of the applicant, with a signature and photo (this includes a current Working With Children card issued in Western Australia)
- (e) Current shooter's or firearm's licence showing a signature and photo (not minor or junior permit or licence)

Secondary use in the community documents

- (a) DFAT issued Certificate of identity
- (b) DFAT issued Document of identity
- (c) DFAT issued United Nations Convention travel document secondary
- (d) Foreign government issued documents (for example, driver's licence). Documents in languages other than English must be accompanied by a NAATI accredited translation
- (e) Medicare card
- (f) Enrolment with the Australian Electoral Commission
- (g) Security Guard/Crowd Control photo licence
- (h) Evidence of right to an Australian government benefit (Centrelink)
- (i) Consular photo identity card issued by DFAT
- (j) Police Force Officer photo identity card
- (k) Australian Defence Force photo identity card

- Commonwealth or state/territory government photo identity card (this may take the form of a working with children or vulnerable people card or a government issued occupational licence)
- (m) Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC)
- (n) Maritime Security Identity Card (MSIC)
- (o) Credit reference check
- (p) Australian tertiary photo identity document
- (q) Australian secondary student photo identity document
- (r) Certified academic transcript from an Australian university
- (s) Trusted referee's report
- (t) Bank card or credit card or bank statement
- (u) State/territory government rates assessment notice or Australian Taxation Office assessment notice
- (v) Australian utility bill showing name and address
- (w) Australian Private Health Insurance Card
- (x) Australian Trade Association card
