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FAQ - My Localadmin Account

What is the localadmin account?

The localadmin account is a local account stored on the notebook. You don't need to be connected to the school network to use this account.

Why use the localadmin account:

The localadmin account has local administrative privileges. This means you'll have access to install software locally on the hard drive. So if you have a digital camera or your own home broadband connection, you are able to install software/drivers.

Which account should I use to login?

When you are using your notebook at school and connected to the network, you can login with your E Number and password. By using your E number you will have access to the school network drives, email and internet access.

If you are using your notebook at home, you should login with your 'localadmin' account.

NOTE: If you are at a LWICT School (100 School Project) you can use your E Number to login at school and at home. ****Should you wish to use the Department-provided Internet dial-up service, you will need to login as localadmin.****

Why shouldn't I use my E number to login at home:

Logging on from home using the domain account while not connected to the network has shown to corrupt the local profile.

Metro and Regional Internet-service diallers will not work under an E number logon.

NOTE: If you are at a LWICT School (100 School Project) you can use your E Number to login at school and at home. ****Should you wish to use the Department-provided Internet dial-up service, you will need to login as localadmin.****
